Iran Trading Policy

In April 2010, Danaher's management determined that Danaher and all of its businesses should cease doing business with or in Iran, after an appropriate wind-down period. The decision reflects Danaher's commitment to being a responsible, worldwide corporate citizen and management's judgment that such action is in the best interests of Danaher's shareholders in light of the business and reputational risks that may arise from doing business in or with Iran. Veralto, a former Danaher company, stands with the decision made by Danaher and continues its commitment to being a responsible, worldwide corporate citizen. Veralto management will continue to follow the policy updated in 2015 which permits shipments of products, under a limited exception, for medical and humanitarian purposes only.¹

¹This exception follows the guidelines as established by the US government for business in or with Iran.
